### **ROAR08 - Reach Out and Recruit A “PROFESSIONAL or REGULAR” Member (ROAR) Membership Campaign Rules and Eligibility**

1. All American Counseling Association (ACA) “Professional or Regular” members in good standing may participate and are eligible to win. In order to be eligible to win the drawing, the referring member must be an active ACA “Professional or Regular” member at the time the campaign ends (December 31, 2008). ACA staff are not eligible to participate. Definition of an ACA “Professional” member: Individual who hold a master’s degree or higher in counseling or a closely related field from a college or university accredited by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation. Definition of an ACA “Regular” member: Individual whose interests and activities are consistent with those of the Association, but who are not qualified for Professional membership.
2. The campaign period runs from July 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.
3. All new ACA member applications and membership dues must be received no later than December 31, 2008 to be counted. The new “Professional or Regular” member is defined as a member who has paid the appropriate dues payments, and has not requested a refund prior to the drawing.
4. The drawings will be held on or before January 15, 2009 at ACA’s office.
5. Two PRIZES will be awarded: \$250 gas card (cannot be substituted for cash) or cash drawing. The cash drawing will begin with \$250, contributed by ACA. For each new “Professional or Regular” member recruited by another member, ACA will contribute \$25 into the cash drawing.
6. For each new “Professional or Regular” member the member recruits, the recruiter’s name will be entered into a drawing. The number of new “Professional or Regular” members recruited determines the odds of winning.
7. To receive credit for referring a new “Professional or Regular” member, the recruiter’s name must appear on the “Referred by” line of the membership application and dues must be paid in full at the time the application is submitted.
8. A new “Professional or Regular” member is defined as an eligible individual who has not been a member of ACA for at least one year or more.
9. Only the “Professional or Regular” membership types are eligible and will be counted towards the drawing.
10. “Professional or Regular” members participating in the campaign agree that the decisions and rules outlined by ACA are final and not open to challenge.
11. Acceptance of prize constitutes permission for ACA to use winner’s name and likeness for advertising, promotional, and other purposes without additional compensation unless prohibited by law.
12. By entering, participants release and hold harmless ACA’s officers and employees from any injuries, loss, damage or liability of any kind arising from or in connection with this campaign or acceptance or use of any prize won.
13. The value of the prizes will be reported to the IRS and other taxing authorities by ACA. The winner will be responsible for all taxes associated with any prize awarded by ACA. The winner will be supplied with a W-9 form to be completed in order to receive payment.
14. The prizes are not transferable.
15. If the winner cannot or will not accept the prize, then the prize will be forfeited and/or awarded to an alternate winner.
16. Any disputes hereunder will be decided by the Executive Director of ACA in his sole discretion, and any such decision is final.
17. No purchase necessary to enter or win. Void where prohibited.
