

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Adultspan Journal seeks manuscripts illuminating current information about research, theory, and practice in the field of adult development and aging. The journal seeks submissions that provide leadership on innovative topics, focusing on developmental principles and concomitant counseling implications. The journal promotes accurate information regarding counseling and adult development with research, practice, literature review, conceptual, and personal journey articles.

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Authors submitting manuscripts to the journal should not simultaneously submit them to another journal, nor should manuscripts have been published elsewhere in substantially similar form or with substantially similar content.

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Abstract: The abstract should express the central idea of the manuscript in nontechnical language. It should be on page 2 and is limited to 25–50 words.

Keywords: Keywords should follow the abstract on page 2 and should include 5 words.
